Featured Projects

Bold, site-responsive works that invite audiences to experience the festival through various expressions of color, material, and movement.

- **Amanda Browder: Zig & Zag**

A large-scale textile installation transforming RAM Downtown's exterior with donated fabrics gathered and assembled through community participation. Inside, *Amanda Browder: Civic Sparkle* extends the experience.

An immersive installation by Minneapolis artist Eric Rieger (HOTTEA), featuring suspended strands of coated yarn that transform the gardens through color, rhythm, and movement.

Recent paintings and works on paper by Chicago artist Dan Devening who explores color, surface, perception, and the relationship between digital and painterly imagery.

A community-driven multi-media exhibition celebrating the importance of the handmade, featuring a large quilt created by Milwaukee-based artist Rosy Petri in collaboration with community members.

Contemporary Midwest art jewelry and small metals rooted in regional material culture and identity.

Intricate polymer micromosaics by Seattle-based artist Cynthia Toops, presented alongside additional jewelry from the artist.
- **Stitched Stories: Narrative Quilts and Textiles**

Fiber-based works exploring how textiles can be used to convey meaning, transport viewers to real or imagined worlds, or tell personal narratives.
- **Tanya Crane: Embodied Histories—Exploring the Legacy of African Jewelry**
Throughout *In/Between*, RAM Downtown
Contemporary jewelry and sculptural works engaging historical West African adornment and exploring identity, exchange, material history, and cultural transmission.
- **Wood You Believe It?: Painted Wood from RAM's Collection**
Opens September 23, RAM Downtown
Furniture, art jewelry, sculpture, and wall hangings demonstrating traditional and experimental approaches to transforming wood with paint.

Supporting Activities

Explore Racine's architecture, history, creative community, and landscape with self-guided experiences.

- **Frank Lloyd Wright Trail in Racine**
A self-guided trail connecting Racine landmarks including the Hardy House and SC Johnson campus, highlighting the city's architecture and design history.
- **Quilts on Barns**
A county-wide public art project bringing quilt patterns into the landscape through painted barn quilts that connect communities, places, and stories.
- **Racine Heritage Museum Walking Tours**
Guided tours exploring Racine's history along downtown streets and the Lake Michigan shoreline.
- **Wall Poems of Racine**
An ArtRoot project with UW–Parkside and community partners pairing excerpts from Racine poets with designs by UW students in public art installations.
