



Racine Art Museum and RAM's Wustum Museum Studio Class COVID-19 Policy

- Students/Teachers with COVID-19 symptoms—fever, cough, shortness of breath, etc.—may not enter RAM or Wustum and will be sent home if they become symptomatic.
 - The museum's management reserves the right to check the temperatures of anyone entering the building, as deemed appropriate.
- If any student has tested positive for COVID-19, they will not be allowed to enter RAM or Wustum and will need to remain home in isolation for a minimum of 14 days and be asymptomatic for a minimum of 72 hours before returning to either campus.
- If any student/teacher is named as a close contact of a positive patient, they will not be allowed to enter RAM or Wustum and will quarantine for a minimum of 14 days from their last day of exposure, and be asymptomatic for a minimum of 72 hours.
 - In addition, if any student or teacher's household members are under quarantine/isolation for close contact of a positive patient, they should follow the above quarantine guidelines.
- If a student or teacher has a confirmed case of COVID-19, the museum staff will undergo a stringent cleaning protocol, with the possibility of shutting down for a time period. *Studio spaces and classes may close, and will be determined by management.*
- Students/Teachers are required to provide and wear **their own facemasks** that cover both the nose and mouth while working.
 - These should be worn at all times in the building and before entering the building.
- Students/Teachers must wash or sanitize hands often and when entering facility. Hand sanitizer is available at the entrances/exits of both campuses each time entering and leaving the buildings.
- Student/Teachers must cover coughs and sneezes using their elbow (not hands) or better, a paper tissue that they dispose of.
- Please use your arm or hip to open doors whenever possible.
- *Please only use the front entrance of the museum when entering the building.*

Social Distancing/ Studio Rules:

- Students/Teachers will practice social distancing by maintaining a distance of at least six feet from other students, teachers and staff at all times.
- Please refrain from socializing in common areas or around the front desk. Only one person at the front desk at all times.
- The small kitchen in between rooms 1 and 2 will be closed to all students.
- There will be no communal coffee available. Please bring your own coffee/water in as needed.
- No more than one person is allowed in a bathroom at a time. Bathroom doors must be propped open after use so others know it is empty when the door is propped open or occupied when the door is closed.

- One person may use common area equipment at a time such as the clay roller, jewelry equipment, stain glass stations, etc. Each of these must be wiped down after by the student or teacher.
- Chairs, tables and other useable spaces are situated to maintain a social distancing – absolutely no moving or rearranging tables, chairs, and wheels will be tolerated.
- Each table and working space will have a decal that designates where the student may sit. No moving of decals.

All the above is subject to change.
