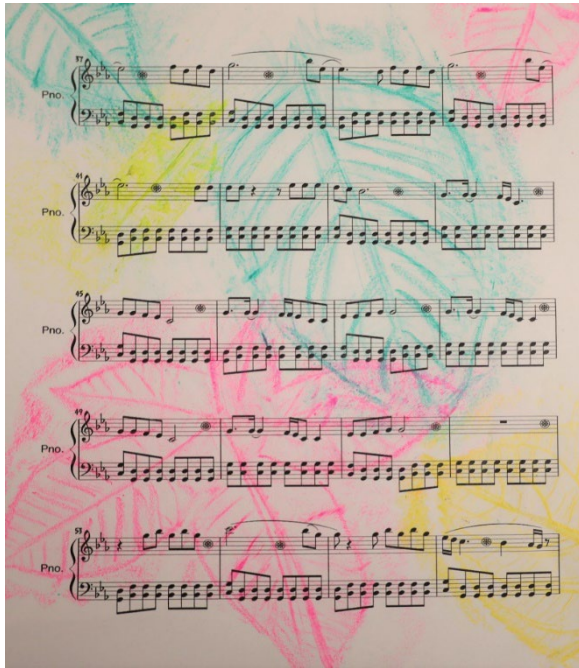


# RAM

## Supplies

- Sheet music
- Leaves
- Crayons

## Instructions

1. Print off sheet 3, or use any sheet music of your own.
2. Collect leaves from outside.
3. Place the leaves under the sheet music and lightly rub a crayon on top.
4. Use the crayon to add additional details to your leaves.
