A juried exhibition for photographers and video artists at RAM's Wustum Museum of Fine Arts, 2519 Northwestern Avenue, Racine, sponsored by the Racine Art Museum.

Juror

John Simmons, ASC, Photographer, Los Angeles, California

Eligibility

Any artist 18 and over residing in Wisconsin, or who has been a resident during the past year or maintains a residence in Wisconsin.

Jurying Fee

\$25 jurying fee, waived for RAM members.

Restrictions

- Original fine art photographs, short (15 minutes or less) video, or digitally generated or enhanced prints. Must be printed to photographic paper, metal, or may be a reverse Plexiglas® print. No canvas. Please specify which surface or type of paper you will be using.
- Work must have been created after 2019. Negatives and digital files that have not been printed or exhibited professionally prior to 2020 are also eligible.
- Work must not have been previously exhibited at RAM's Wustum Museum.
- Work must not have been created under the direct supervision of an instructor.
- Entries must be submitted using the online form at ramart.org.
Photographers: Submit a portfolio of 10 digital images saved at 300 dpi, no larger than 6 inches on the longest side, and less than 1MB.
Videographers: Submit up to two movie files saved as .mov or .mp4 files.

Submitting your entry to this exhibition constitutes an agreement on your part with the conditions set forth in this prospectus, and grants RAM permission to reproduce your work for publicity and catalogue purposes. Failure to pick up accepted work before December 30, 2022 will be taken as an intention on the part of the artist to abandon the work. Abandonment legally dispossesses the artist of title to the work. This will allow RAM, as possessor of the work, to claim good title to it and dispose of it at the museum's own discretion.

Valuation

Prices may not be changed after entry and should include the cost of framing. Please note that RAM collects a 40% commission on works that sell from the exhibition. If your entry is not for sale (NFS), please indicate an insurance value.

Purchase Awards

RAM is offering multiple Purchase Awards to acquire photographs for the museum's collection. Most of these are \$200 each. Regardless of retail price, the artist would receive \$200 (or the Purchase Award amount) in exchange for their work. Please check the appropriate box online if you want to be considered for a Purchase Award. RAM also reserves the right to purchase works at 60% of the retail price, which may be more or less than the standard Purchase Award of \$200.

Accepted Works

Photographs selected by the juror must be framed and wired for hanging. Sawtooth hangers are not acceptable. RAM reserves the right to refuse any accepted works that do not meet the museum's standards for quality, presentation, and framing. Purchase Award decisions will be finalized based on framed pieces. Works selected for *Wisconsin Photography 2022* may not be substituted or removed from the exhibition. **While all works will be labeled and priced in accordance with information furnished by the artist**, RAM reserves the right to alter details for clarity and to adhere to branding guidelines.
