This summer, we are pleased to welcome new neighbors across Monument Square, Hotel Verdant. A long-dormant retail building has now been reimagined as a contemporary and cozy boutique hotel. Local artists have created all the artworks in the hotel's public areas. The Hotel Verdant Collection has been co-curated by RAM in collaboration with ArtRoot and selected by Verdant's developers, Dominion Properties. You will see works in a variety of media throughout Verdant. In addition, high quality printed reproductions of pieces from RAM's permanent collection created by Robert W. Burkert and Ruth Grotenrath, are featured in the guestrooms.

Our Favorite Time of the Year

A Note of Thanks from RAM Director of Operations and Development Laura D'Amato Wow, I sure LOVE this time of year! Why? Because this is when we prepare and distribute RAM's Annual Contributors Report.

This report recognizes and honors the hundreds of individuals, foundations, organizations, corporations, businesses, and volunteers whose gifts of time and money made 2022 a very special year. Happily, most



pandemic-related costs and protocols slowly subsided while visitor attendance was within 90% of pre-COVID levels. As always, RAM's world-class exhibitions and award-winning education programs simply wouldn't exist without you. I'm also happy to tell you about some new funding partnerships that occurred in 2022. Without all of you, RAM and Wustum simply wouldn't exist.

2022 Financial Highlights

• Applied for and received forgiveness for RAM's second **Payroll Protection Plan** (PPP) loan from the **Small Business Administration**. This allowed RAM to use the funds without having to pay back any of the principal or interest.



- Received the loan of a large-scale artwork, *Lost at Sea*, by Edouard Duval-Carrié, for RAM's *Blurry Boundaries* exhibition that included generous funding for related outreach education programming from *Art Bridges Foundation*, Bentonville, Arkansas.
- Received funding from the newly formed **Ruth Foundation** for the Arts (Ruth Arts) that

was built upon the inspiration and vision of **Ruth DeYoung Kohler**. The Foundation marked its debut in the national landscape of arts philanthropy in 2022.

- Worked with a consortium of 12 Wisconsin-based art museums to apply for and receive a two-year **Joint Effort Marketing (JEM) Grant** awarded by **Travel Wisconsin.** This grant supported collaborative research to learn the public's thoughts about Wisconsin art museums and how to better understand visitor perceptions, their taste in art, and what might motivate or dissuade them from visiting.
- The Ruffo Family Foundation, David Charak, and Andis Foundation provided a one-to-one match for the first \$33,000 resulting in RAM's most successful #GivingTuesday and Year-End Campaign to date, exceeding the gift amount from the previous highest year (2021) by 2.5%. Since 2017, we have seen this drive increase giving totals by 213.6%.

RAM's Board and staff are beyond grateful that our members, donors, and funding partners enabled our mission-critical exhibitions and education programming to persist and thrive throughout 2022.

Wustum Museum of Fine Arts, RAM has been focused on steadily building and exhibiting a world-class collection of contemporary craft and works on paper. 2013 brought the recognition that RAM's collection of contemporary craft is the largest in North America. This feat is due to the dedication and hard work of numerous people, as well as financial support. The exhibitions currently on view, acknowledging RAM's Twentieth Anniversary year, reflect the foundations of the museum's collection as well as further growth.

Gathering Voices at RAM: 20 Years of Building America's Largest Contemporary Craft Collection is a look at assembling a stellar collection of clay, glass, metal, art jewelry, wood, and polymer. With an emphasis on works acquired in the last five to seven years, it also highlights critical and more expansive directions to be taken.

Vignettes: Concentrated Views of RAM's Collection is comprised of several smaller exhibitions of works gathered under various organizing principles or themes. Featuring textiles, art to wear, art jewelry, photography, prints, ceramics, and more, this atypical presentation highlights the range of the permanent collection in its variability of artist voices and backgrounds as well as types of media.





Most directly representing one way RAM is growing its holdings, RAM Showcase: Four Jewelers and the Artists of Color Acquisition Fund highlights recently acquired art jewelry. Utilizing rich and varied materials like sea grass, silicone, recycled keychains, and bronze, the artists whose works are included create evocative and poetic adornment. Significantly, every piece is new to RAM as part of the first round of acquisitions specifically focused on supporting artists of color.

underscores the beginning of RAM's collecting. Early gifts donated through the 1930s Federal Art Project/Works Progress Administration (WPA)—primarily textiles, drawings, watercolors, prints, and photography—foreshadowed the collecting directions of Wustum and RAM with

an emphasis on contemporary craft, works on paper, and works by women.

Rounding out current shows, *Open Close Front Back: Exploring Contemporary Art Jewelry Design* encourages looking from new or different perspectives. This exhibition celebrates artistic design and innovation by emphasizing the consideration of art jewelry from new angles—sometimes literally.

Peter F. Aymonin and Lisa Bigalke received two of the four RAM Artist Fellowships awarded in 2022. With that honor comes a stipend for each recipient as well as a concurrent solo show in the RAM Artist Fellowship and Emerging Artist Exhibition 2023 at Wustum. Curator of Exhibitions Lena Vigna spoke with Aymonin and Bigalke.

Please share the basics of your art career thus far.

Peter F. Aymonin: I am originally from Miami, Florida, but have been living in Sturtevant for over a decade. I spent much of my professional career in journalism, a different way to express my creative side than ceramic. A stroke in 2018 changed my life, leaving an imprint on my artwork.

Would you please describe your work?

Aymonin: I have always worked with a variety of media. In early pieces, I addressed political, personal, and technical themes. I used both hands to form sculptures. But after the stroke, my focus turned towards my health. I knew that my love of creating art would help me heal. So I continued my work in clay, but moved to using a pinching technique using just one hand. My creations have become reminiscent of coral reefs, ocean life, and flowers.



Lisa Bigalke: I am a printmaker and could happily print every day. This body of work is about the life and history of extinct and endangered animals of North America. In addition to the tactile changes between collaged paper and embroidery, I enjoy playing with all the different line quality that is available in relief, intaglio, lithography, and silkscreen printmaking.







What inspires you most these days?

Bigalke: While I am inspired by hiking, gardens, fossils, Wisconsin, landscapes, extinction, books, color, and pattern, I really love learning. Over the last couple of years—with some encouragement—I've made a stop motion animation, found inspiration to learn several new Spanish long stitch bindings, and taken lithography into the kitchen by making plates out of aluminum foil and etching them with Coca Cola.

Art Education

Zero Waste Art Program Outreach 5 Program **Art Classes and Camps Full Steam Ahead**



Fall 2022 saw the return of Racine Unified School District (RUSD) in-person education programs at RAM's Wustum Museum after a two-year hiatus due to COVID.

In addition, the 8th Grade Zero Waste Art Program was held in person at Wustum for the first time ever during the 2022-23 school year. For this new program, RAM educators teach RUSD 8th grade art students about artists in RAM's collection—and around the world—

who primarily use recycled materials, and rework them into creative expression in thought-provoking ways.

Students in the program are also challenged to create their own works of art using waste materials collected from Racine area businesses and manufacturers. The program was designed in part to help organizations recognize the amount of waste they produce and find new ways of using these materials creatively—keeping them them out of our lakes, rivers, and landfills. The Zero Waste Art Program also highlights how much excess waste we produce as a country and encourages students to innovate ideas for re-use

The RAM education team is also thrilled to have the Outreach 5 Program back on campus at Wustum. This program welcomes all RUSD 5th grade classes for two-hour tours accompanied by hands-on making

experiences. The education team loved having classrooms filled with RUSD students again, and is thrilled to continue offering these important school-based programs.



Summer 2023 art education programs are now in full swing. This year, Wustum will host over 20 art classes for adults, and five weeks of kids classes and camps. There is something for everyone—

paper arts, drawing, painting, jewelry, ceramics, and even a class for kids that explores the art of inventor Rube Goldberg.

Full Steam Ahead returns to Wustum on Saturday, August 12. Be amazed as local printmakers use a steamroller as a large-scale

printing press! There will be (large!) artwork for sale, free family activities,

food trucks, and more.

Kelly Witte received an Emerging Artist Award, a new category awarded with the RAM Artist Fellowships starting in 2020. With that honor comes a stipend and a concurrent solo show in the RAM Artist Fellowship and Emerging Artist Exhibition 2023 at Wustum. Curator of Exhibitions Lena Vigna spoke with Witte about her work.

How often are you in your studio?

Kelly Witte: I am in my studio as often as possible. I am grateful that I have an area in my home that is solely dedicated to artmaking...I also use my time in the studio for marketing, communicating with clients and collectors, and submitting applications for exhibitions. I find that the long, cold Wisconsin winters lend themselves well to spending extra time in my studio. However, once the summer rolls around I bring my work outside to enjoy the sunshine and warm weather.

What inspires you most these days?

Witte: The inspiration for my artwork comes from studying former fashions and vintage advertisements, perusing library books, and browsing through old family photos. I enjoy classic sitcoms and often take mental note of the characters' hairstyles and wardrobe, and incorporate those into my work...My home was built in the early 1960s and I am slowly working to renovate it. I frequent flea markets, estate sales, and thrift shops on the quest for just the right mid-century items to furnish my space. During these excursions, I become immersed in vintage home decor and am exposed to unique color schemes and patterns that influence my art.

A. Many planned gifts can be adjusted as needed. Often, a gift amount can increase or decrease based on economic conditions, memorial opportunities, or personal family issues.
