Father's Day Agamograph

An agamograph is a series of images that change at different angles. This type of art is named after Yaacov Agam who is known for using this technique to make optical and kinetic art.



Supplies

- Colored Pencils, Markers, or Crayons
- Scissors
- Glue
- Printer – to print out the templates

Directions

1. Print out the two pages of templates at the end of this document, you will need them to complete your agamograph.
2. Inside of the Picture 1 and Picture 2 templates, draw different pictures using colored pencils, markers, or crayons. The example is Father's Day themed, but you can draw whatever you'd like.
3. Use the scissors to cut each colored picture following the rectangular boxes as a guide.
4. Begin to match each number and letter to the blank template, alternating the picture strips you cut out.
5. Glue down each colored rectangular strip to the blank template with the matching number or letter.
6. Crease at every fold to create the shape of an accordion, and voilà!
