Aluminum Foil Mono Prints



Supplies

- Aluminum foil
- Paper – heavy or watercolor
- Paints – tempera or acrylic
- Brushes – different sizes
- Q tips
- Sharpies (optional)

Directions

1. Take a piece of aluminum foil roughly the size of your paper and lay flat on table.
2. Pour paint directly onto foil.
3. Spread paint with your fingers or a paint brush.
4. Mix colors directly on the foil.
5. Add more paint colors on top to create your desired image.
6. Work rather quickly to capture the print while paint is still wet.
7. Scrap off areas of paint with finger, brush, or Q tip, if desired.
8. Once painting on foil is complete, lay a piece of paper on top and rub the back of paper, making sure all areas are thoroughly rubbed.
9. Pull your paper off. Voila! You have a print!
10. After pulling the print, let it dry. Add in details with sharpies, if desired.
11. Use the same foil to create another mono print.
