

Finish the Masterpiece



Supplies

- Printed Image
- Paper thick tag or watercolor paper 9x12 inches or larger
- Glue
- Painters Tape
- Pencil and Ruler
- Drawing Materials of Your Choice or Painting Materials and Brush

Directions



1. Find a masterpiece online that you can download and print. Or, use one of the images below: *Blue Morning Glories* by Georgia O'Keeffe, *Portrait of Madame Matisse* by Henri Matisse, or *Sunflowers* by Vincent Van Gogh

- 2. Print the image.
- 3. Cut paper printed image in half.
- 4. Glue one half down to 9 x 12 inches or larger paper.
- 5. Measure where the other half of image would go on paper. Mark with pencil.
- 6. Tape around the edges of where your image will go.
- 7. Using drawing or painting materials, finish the painting.

8. Will you try to make it look like the original? Mimic the same colors and expression of the original? Or will you make up your own design?

9. When complete and dry, take the tape off.
