

Nature Walk Cardboard Vase

Go out and explore nature to enjoy this recycled Earth Day-inspired project! Gather flowers on an outdoor walk, then create a cardboard "vase" to display your collected plants.

Supplies

- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Marker

Instructions

- 1. Cut a square from cardboard no smaller than 5×5 inches.
- 2. Use your marker to draw a vase on the bottom of the cardboard.
- 3. Poke 5–10 holes above the vase using scissors—kids should ask an adult for help.
- 4. Go for a walk and collect a variety of flowers and plants
- 5. Insert the stems of the plants into the holes in the cardboard.
- 6. Hang and enjoy!
