

Washable Markers Watercolor Flowers







Supplies

- Washable markers
- Water
- Paint Brush
- Paper (watercolor paper works best)







Directions for Multi-Flower Marker Watercolor Painting

- 1. Draw flower designs with markers. Loose drawings work best.
- 2. Start with one color then add one or two more colors to each flower. Add more flowers.
- 3. Using brush, paint each flower with water. Keep your brush wet, and let the water move the marker around to create a washy look.



4. Finish painting all flowers with water.




5. Draw leaves where desired with markers. Use several shades of yellow and green.




6. Paint leaves with water, again staying loose. Put some of the marker paint on the brush and add more green in and around the flowers. Let Dry.


Blue Hydrangea Style Marker Watercolor Flowers






