Entry Requirements

Eligibility

Artists living in Racine, Kenosha, or Walworth County, and RAM members residing anywhere in the United States, who are 18 years of age or older. Not a member? Become one today at ramart.org/memberships.

Entry Fee

\$20 entry fee per artist payable upon registration, free for RAM members.

Requirements and Specifications

- One or two works made after January 1, 2021 may be entered.
- Work must be ready for display. 2-D work must be framed and wired for hanging. Sawtooth hangers are unacceptable.
- Frame(s) of two-dimensional work must be a minimum of eight inches and a maximum of 72 inches in any direction. Three-dimensional work must be no larger than 72 inches high x 48 inches wide x 48 inches deep. Sizes outside these requirements are unacceptable.
- Artists are invited to explore any media for this exhibition; however, the museum cannot accept entries that include liquids, food, soil, or living organisms.
- RAM exhibition and marketing materials will list art media per submitted *Identification Label(s)*. RAM reserves the right to alter information for clarification and to adhere to branding guidelines.
- Work must not have been previously exhibited onsite at RAM and/or Wustum.

Submission of Entries

Valuation of Submitted Work

Prices may not be changed after entry, and should represent the retail price of the final work on display. Please note that RAM collects at 40% commission on works that are for sale. If your entry is not for sale (NFS), please include an insurance value.

Insurance and Liability

Entries will be handled with care, but RAM is not responsible for loss or damage from any cause whatsoever during jurying. RAM assumes liability for works selected for exhibition. Submitting artwork to this competition constitutes an agreement by the artists with RAM to photograph and reproduce work for publicity and catalogue purposes.

Juror

Debra Brehmer is the owner and director of Portrait Society Gallery of Contemporary Art in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. She also writes for the national art publication, *Hyperallergic*. Prior to running a gallery, Brehmer taught art history at the Milwaukee Institute of Art & Design and was the founder and publisher of *Art Muscle Magazine*. In 2023, she was awarded a Mayoral Proclamation for service to the art community, and in 2022 received a Wisconsin Achievement Award for Critical Writing from the Humanities Council, Wisconsin Visual Artists, and Museum of Wisconsin Art. A recent major exhibition organized by Portrait Society, *Art Against the Odds: Wisconsin Prison Art*, is currently touring for two years.
