## All media juried competition to open at Wustum Museum

RACINE — Charles A. Wustum Museum of Fine Arts, a campus of the Racine Art Museum at 2519 Northwestern Ave., continues a museum tradition with the opening of "Racine and Vicinity Show: All Media Juried Competition" Saturday, June 4.

A glimpse into local talent, this juried exhibition showcases work from artists residing throughout Racine, Kenosha and Walworth counties, along with RAM members from outside the area. The show continues through Aug. 27 and features 117

accepted pieces by 103 artists.

Of the unprecedented 504 pieces submitted by 210 artists, less than one-quarter of the pieces were chosen for this year's show. More than \$1,000 in prizes will be awarded at the opening reception to the artists whose pieces are selected as the best in the show.

Graeme Reid selected the works to be included, as well as the awards for this year's exhibition. He is assistant director at the Museum of Wisconsin Art.

The opening reception will be held from 2 to 4 p.m. The awards presentation will begin at 3 p.m.
