'Watercolor Wisconsin' opens at Wustum Museum

RACINE — "Watercolor Wisconsin 2015," a longstanding Racine tradition, is open through April 23 at Wustum Museum, a campus of the Racine Art Museum at 2519 Northwestern Ave. The exhibit features 117 works of art by 94 artists.

Limited only by their materials — aqueous media such as acrylic and watercolor — artists are free to create both two-dimensional and three-dimensional works on paper. This year's show features a variety of subjects, from animals, flowers and landscape to figurative studies and the abstract.


