Artists are invited to submit up to two works in two separate categories only: handmade ornaments—no largers than $5 \times 5 \times 5$ inches; decorated trees—no larger than $12 \text{ high } \times 5 \times 5$ inches; or gift wrapped boxes—no larger than $6 \times 6 \times 6$ inches.

AdORNAMENTS entries must be delivered to the Racine Art Museum, 441 Main Street, by 4:00 pm on Saturday, November 14. This cheery and creative holiday show will be on display at the downtown Racine museum throughout the holiday season, November 20 – December 30, 2020.

Together, the two campuses of the Racine Art Museum, RAM in downtown Racine at 441 Main Street and the Charles A. Wustum Museum of Fine Arts at 2519 Northwestern Avenue, seek to elevate the stature of contemporary crafts to that of fine art by exhibiting significant works in craft media with painting, sculpture, and photography, while providing outstanding educational art programming.

After temporarily closing its doors in response to the global COVID-19 pandemic, RAM reopened to the public on Wednesday, August 5. RAM's Wustum Museum of Fine Arts reopened on Wednesday, September 2 with the juried exhibition, *Wisconsin Photography 2020*. Both museums are operating with limited hours, open Wednesday through Saturday from Noon to 4:00 pm.
